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## Program Services

### The Holland Free Health Clinic:

- Seeks to assist citizens of the Holland-Zeeland Community who do not have prescription coverage and cannot afford to pay for prescription medication, eye exams and dental care
- Assists clients with the application process for free and discounted medications available from manufacturers
- Coordinates client care within the Holland Free Dental Network
- Provides free eye exams one day per week. Coordinates free or discounted eye glasses.
- Maintains ongoing communication with the clients dentist, physician and participating pharmaceutical companies

## How does the program work?

- The Clinic utilizes volunteers to assist clients in filling out applications for free prescription medications.
- When approved, the medication is delivered to the client's home or physician's office, to be picked up by the client.

## Is this service free?

- YES, this is a FREE service. Assistance is available by appointment only, call (616) 392-3610 for an appointment.

## How do I know if I am eligible?

- If you are not a Veteran
- Ineligible for Medicaid (Some spend down or co-pay considered on a case by case basis).
- Have no insurance coverage for prescriptions.
- Have an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines AND provide proof of income regardless of whether or not the manufacturer requires it.
- Assets allowed:
  - One home per household
  - One car per driver per household
  - \$5000 assets *per person* (retirement, bank accounts, investments, etc.)
- Client's physician must be practicing in at Holland or Zeeland Community Hospitals. Clients must reside in the City of Holland or one of the following 6 townships: Fillmore, Holland, Laketown, Park, Zeeland, West Olive.
- Only long term medication assistance is provided. No controlled substances, over the counter, or short term medications (such as antibiotics) are available.

## How do I apply?

- New clients must call during business hours to schedule an eligibility screening appointment. The client will be required to call at an agreed upon time to determine eligibility.
- If eligible, a scheduled appointment will be made in which the client brings in all required documentation and the initial applications and forms are filled out and signed. At that time if all the information is complete the client will be enrolled and the process to obtain medications will be started.
- Please call for an appointment.

## What information will I need to provide?

- Most recent 30 days of documented income.
- Latest bank statement for all accounts.
- Asset documentation.
- Tax Return—Federal.
- Copy of all insurance cards.
- Medicaid denial or spend down letter.
- Medicare Part D subsidy denial or approval letter.

## How long does it take to get medication?

- When accepted and enrolled in the program it will take 4-6 weeks to receive your first shipments of medications. We recommend asking your doctor for samples until your medications arrive.
